Many of you will remember the highly successful Liverpool Philharmonic Schools' concerts and were disappointed when they were no longer held at King George's Hall.

We are delighted to announce that the Hallé Orchestra are now able to do their school's concert in Blackburn with Darwen. This year the concert will have an Olympic theme and will include a song for everyone to learn beforehand, 'Chase down the Sun'. This has been composed especially for these concerts by Steve Pickett, education director at the Hallé with words by Terry Caffrey, writer in residence at the Bridgewater Hall.

Blackburn with Darwen Music Service are significantly subsidising this concert to enable as many schools and pupils as possible to experience a full scale orchestra at this large venue (performing an appropriate repertoire).

Tickets for bookings reaching the Music Service by **May 17** will be **£1 per** pupil with one free adult place for every 10 child tickets. Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis – please see the attached booking form.
